<u>General Supply Needs</u> – If nothing is listed for a specific course, you can assume the general supplies are sufficient.

- <u>Class Binders</u>: The majority of classes require a binder. It is highly recommended that students consider purchasing a large 3" binder for all classes or a 2 ½-3" binders for odd/even days. You may choose to purchase individual 1-2" binders for each class.
- <u>Spiral notebooks</u>: Some students prefer to take notes in spiral notebooks vs. looseleaf. Most classes leave this to your discretion unless otherwise specified.
- <u>Laptop</u>: This should be a PC or Mac (please see tech sheet)
- <u>Writing utensils</u>: Pencils and Pens (note: many math classes require pencils)
- Expo Markers: Some teachers request a small pack of expo markers as a way of contributing to class supplies.
- Notebook Paper: College Rule (note: Graph paper is used periodically in most math classes)
- <u>Tissue Boxes:</u> All students should bring one tissue box to turn in at the front office.
