The First-Year Shelton Challenge is a six-day summer experience for rising freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors in high school. Shelton's five cornerstones of values-based leadership—honesty, integrity, compassion, diversity and social responsibility—are the foundations of the camp. The core curriculum focuses on Personal Leadership Assessment and Interpersonal Dynamics, Role of Values and Ethics in Leadership, Leadership Traits and Approaches, Teambuilding and Empowering Others, Social Responsibility, Public Speaking, and Goal Setting.

The First-Year Shelton Challenge seeks youth who are **rising 9th through 12th graders** with a 3.0 grade point average (unweighted) or higher. Students will get to experience residence hall living, eat meals at a campus dining hall, and use indoor and outdoor recreation facilities. Cost to attend the program is \$700.00 for the week.

- The Young Scholars Program is a 5-year pre-college scholarship for students with high financial need, academic ability,

leadership, persistence, and a desire to help others.

- From eighth grade through senior high of school, Young Scholars receive the following support from the Cooke Foundation:
 - a personal academic and college counselor
 - funding for academic and enrichment programs in the summer and during the school year, such as music and art lessons, extra academic classes, and service opportunities
 - internship and study abroad opportunities
 - educational resources including books and technology
 - pathway to the Cooke Foundation's \$40,000 per year college scholarship

Logistics:

- Be in 7th grade and plan to enter 8th grade in the fall
- Earn all or mostly As and no Cs since 6th grade
- Submit grades, standardized test scores, essays, and letters of recommendation

When are applications due:

- Applications open in February and close in April of 7th grade. Selected students are notified in the fall of 8th grade.

- This program is for students from low income backgrounds. Students who are first generation college students will be looked at for special consideration as well. This scholarship is made for students who have shown leadership potential. Logistics of the Program LEDA Scholars receive leadership training, writing instruction, standardized test preparation and a year of highly personalized guidance as they navigate the application and admissions process at the most competitive colleges. Throughout college and beyond, Scholars are offered ongoing advising, career counseling, postgraduate planning and community-building support to help them succeed and lead.
- This program is composed of a 7-week leadership program and then continued college guidance through the application process and throughout college

Logistics

- This program is made for students who are in the 11th grade and go to a public high school
- The unweighted cumulative GPA requirement is at least 3.6 and class ranking within the top 10% of the high school class
- Students need to have taken the most rigorous courses available
- Exceptional analytical reading and writing skills, demonstrating preparedness for selective colleges and universities
- Scores above the national average on the PSAT, SAT, PLAN, and/or ACT

When are applications typically due:

- The National Security Language Initiative for Youth (NSLI-Y) program, sponsored by the U.S. Department of State, provides merit-based scholarships for high school students to study less commonly taught languages in countries where they're spoken. Applicants choose a language (Russian, Arabic, Turkish, Mandarin, Korean, Persian, or Hindi) and a duration (either six weeks over the summer or an entire school year). - Both YES (Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and Study) and CBYX (Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange) provide full
